Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

Initial- \$450.00 per student

Refresher- \$175.00 per student

- Minimum of 12 and up to 24 students per class
- Additional pricing for manuals but not required
- Prerequisite- valid BLS Provider CPR card or equivalent

Three Day Elective EMT Refresher

Three day- \$300.00 per student

One day- \$115.00 per student

- Minimum of 25 students
- No maximum number of students
- All students will receive a certificate will have the course listed on their NJOEMS transcript

ICS 100 & NIMS 700- \$750.00

ICS 200- \$5000.00

ICS 300- \$7000.00

- No minimum or maximum number of students
- Certifications do not expire
- ICS 200 and up require two instructors

Extended Travel Fee

Classes scheduled that have a longer travel distance or commute time for instructors may factor into an increased cost for the course and will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

Cancellation Policy

- Any agency or individually registered for course can cancel up to 10 days advance for a full reimbursement
 - Reimbursement does not include credit card processing fees if originally paid for by credit card
- Agencies and individuals can cancel or rescheduled on a case-by-case basis if the reason for cancelation is considered an emergency (weather related, family, conflicts due to a professional obligation etc.)
 - o Reimbursements within 10 days will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.
- In the event that not enough students register to meet the above listed minimum attendance requirements, any student or agency who has paid for the class will have the option to reschedule or have a full refund.

Attendance

Students or agencies must arrive on time and be present for the duration of the course to receive a certificate. Students arriving more than 15 minutes late may be denied entry altogether or allowed to participate on a case-by-case basis.

 The registration fee is forfeited if the student or agency does not show up for the scheduled course and cannot receive a refund

Purchase Orders (PO)

Agencies/individuals can pay via a Purchase Order. The PO must be issued prior to the date of the class and payment must be received within 30 days of the completion of the course. Any payment not received within 30 days of the completion of the course will have a 15% late fee added to the total invoice. Student certificates may also be withheld due to non-payment.
